Addendum No. 1 to the plans and specifications for the Nottawaseppi Huron Band of the Potawatomi Contract A - Generators as prepared by Wightman & Associates, Inc., dated January, 2010.

This Addendum No. 1 supplements and modifies the Contract Documents relating to the above referenced project. This Addendum shall be deemed a part of the Contract Documents, and to the extent that the provisions of the other Contract Documents are in conflict herewith, this Addendum and Clarification shall control.

1. Enclosed please find a list of the Liquid Propane Gas Suppliers as forwarded by the Band.
2. Enclosed are the Mechanical and Electrical permit applications that the contractor will be required to submit and be reimbursed by the Band.
3. Enclosed is a list of people who attended the pre-bid meeting.
4. Change of address of acceptance of bids: New address is 1474 Mno Bmadzewen Way, Fulton, MI 49052. This is at the reception desk of the health center.
5. Progress Schedule – add 28 days to each milestone as listed on PS-3. Residential shall be installed and started up 68 calendar days after Notice to Proceed, Commercial shall be 103 calendar days after Notice to Proceed, and 113 calendar days for Final Completion.
6. All three (3) commercial buildings have existing security systems in place and are currently monitored by Knight Watch.
7. The Health Building transfer switch will be relocated next to the generator set and not on the building. Provide post and struts to mount the transfer switch next to the concrete pad.
8. Approved manufacturers for this project shall include GENERAC, CUMMINGS, and KOHLER.
9. Commercial generator sets – Motor RPM for base bid shall be 3600 RPM. Provide an alternate bid item for the motor RPM of 1800 RPM.
10. Load bank testing shall be a two (2) hour test with a resistive type.

11. Transfer switch mechanism and controls are to be mounted in a NEMA 3R enclosure in lieu of the NEMA 4 specified.
12. All residential transfer switches shall be 200 amp as shown on the drawings.
13. All commercial generator sets shall have some sound attenuation control to be rated at no more than 75 db at 23 feet.
14. Switch over for the commercial units shall be after hours. Coordinate with Owners representative when this will occur. Provide 48 hour notice minimum.
15. Restoration – see attached letter concerning the grasses to be used at the different locations.

Restoration Activities following Generator Installation on NHBP Buildings

With scheduled installation of back-up generators at residential and community buildings on the NHBP Reservation there will be minor earth disturbance related to the installation.

Consistent with LEED Certification for select buildings on the reservation campus, a low maintenance seed was utilized. Specific seed sources and types were used. Restoration seeding, to remain consistent with the LEED status should be addressed.

For the residential homes, the seed for restoration activities should be a slow-grow low-mow fescue mix. The initial supplier for this seed was the Michigan Wildflower Farm out of Portland MI. See Michigan Native Plant Producers Association flier (or website www.MNPPA.org) for details and links. Their "Eco-Turf Low Maintenance mix" was used for seeding in fall of 2009 for the most recently built tribal homes. This mix will be complimentary with existing conditions for the other residential homes being addressed in this project.

For the commercial installations, adjacent to the administrative and community buildings on the reservation, the low maintenance landscaping grass was primary "Buffalo Grass (*Buchoe dactyloides*)" for the turf producing plant. South sides of the Health Center and Community center were planted to Buffalo Grass and are entering their third growing season. Any disturbance in this area, south of and between the buildings should be re-seeded with Buffalo Grass. Most of the MNPPA member groups should be able to supply Buffalo Grass sufficient to address restoration needs for this project.
